# Turk coup targeted rise of Moslems

In addition to ending a murderous wave of left and right-wing terrorism, a key goal of the military coup Friday in Turkey was to halt the growing influence of Islamic fundamentalists encouraged by the rise to power of Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini in neighboring Iran.

Turkey's 43 million people are 98 percent Moslem. But the country has been governed for more than 50 years by a constitution that gives religion no place in government.

Modern Turkey was founded in the early 1920s from the ruins of the Ottoman Empire by Mustafa Kemal, or Ataturk, a military genius who was determined to end the power of the country's religious leaders.

A geographical bridge between Europe and Asia, Turkey lies 97 percent in the Middle East, bounded by Syria, Iraq, Iran and the Soviet Union. But Ataturk pledged to make the country, bigger than Texas, part of Europe.

He outlawed the veil and the fez and abolished the Persian-Arabic script, forcing Turks to adopt a Latin alphabet.

Portraits and statues of Ataturk, who died in 1938, still adorn public squares, public buildings and Turkish homes. His austere tomb dominates a hill in Ankara, the capital he established in the midst of Anatolia, Turkey's Asian plain, to emphasize his control over the vast nation.

The basic issue of separation of religion and state was challenged by the country's Moslem fundamentalists, who were encouraged by the Islamic revolution in Iran and Khomeini's victory over the late Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi.

"Secularism is atheism," said a slogan at a recent rally in Konya, the central Turkish city known for its "whirling dervishes" and now reputedly a hotbed of Islamic revival.

Turkey's main Islamic figure, Necmettin Erbakan, is an ardent Khomeini backer. His National Salvation Party organized the rally a day after what sympathizers saw as a major political victory.

## Coup disturbs Western allies

BRUSSELS, Belgium (AP) — America's Western allies expressed concern Friday over the potential effect of the military takeover in Turkey, a NATO member, and called for a quick return to democratic rule.

And a leading French newspaper suggested the United States acquiesced in the coup.

Turkey has had increasingly close ties with the European Common Market. Eight of the nine common market countries are members of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, and interests of the two bodies often overlap.

The respected Paris newspaper *Le Monde* said: "The news (of the coup) was given by the American State Department and quickly confirmed by the Turkish ambassador in Washington, while the other Turkish representatives abroad were unaware of it. That fact alone leads one to believe that the United States did not discourage the perpetrators of this operation, particularly as it coincided with NATO maneuvers just beginning in western (Turkish) Thrace."

Although NATO headquarters had no official comment, members of the 15 national delegations said privately the alliance's greatest fear was a violent reaction to the military takeover. Some pointed out there has been growing Moslem fundamentalism in Turkey that opposes its membership in NATO and its ties with the common market.

The common market, whose foreign ministers already were scheduled to meet in Brussels Monday, will discuss the Turkish coup, officials said.
